



BUSINESS LICENSE APPLICATION 2017 LIQUOR LICENSE REQUEST—ADDENDUM 1

Liquor License Definitions:

An issued Liquor License shall allow the licensee to sell and offer for sale at retail, only at the premises specified in such license, alcoholic liquor for use or consumption or resale but limited to the terms of the specific classification other local ordinances as well as state laws. Licensing is a privilege and not a guaranteed right. You cannot purchase or sell alcohol without a valid local liquor license properly posted and each employee seller/server obtaining BASSET certification.

A's On Premise sale (all liquor—for consumption only)

A1	Bar/Tavern	\$700
A2	Restaurant (full menu during alcohol service)	\$700
A3	Banquet Facility	\$2,500
A4	Gaming Parlor (limited space/menu)	\$5,000
A5	Not For Profit (limited hours)	\$300
A6	Special Event Host	\$200/day

C Retail sale (all liquor—no consumption) **\$600**

Classifications (beer/wine only)

B's On Premise sale (beer/wine—for consumption only)

B1	Bar/Tavern	\$600
B2	Restaurant (full menu during alcohol service)	\$500
B3	Banquet Facility	\$2,000
B4	Gaming Parlor (limited space/menu)	\$4,000
B5	Not For Profit (limited hours)	\$250
B6	Special Event Host	\$150/day

D Retail sale (beer/wine only—no consumption) **\$500**

* First time liquor license applicants are also required to pay a non-refundable \$1,000 initial application processing fee.

The following documents and information are **REQUIRED** prior to receiving your local liquor license:

- Photocopy of **Certificate of Insurance** (not the "Policy Declaration") for both General Liability and DRAM shop coverage;
- Federal Employer Identification Number** (FEIN). Call 800-829-3676 if you have questions;
- Illinois Business Tax** (Sales Tax Account) Number. www.tax.illinois.gov or call 217-785-3707 if you have questions;
- A **floor plan** of the premises or place of business which is to be operated under such license, including the portions to be used for storage of liquor, as well as the portions to be used for the sale or service of liquor;
- Check or Money Order** for the application/license fee payable to the "Village of Monee";
- Photocopy of **\$10,000 Surety Bond** payable to the Village of Monee;
- Completed Business License **Contact Information Forms** for each owner/officer/partner/director/manager (whether or not they own any stock) as well as shareholders with interests equal to or exceeding 5%;
- In consideration of Illinois Public Act 99-0046, the Village of Monee requires the holders of all liquor licenses to obtain Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) certifications for each person serving for consumption or selling for carry out and each certificate **MUST** be on file with the Village as well as copies posted adjacent to the business and liquor licenses within public view. This certification is required for all servers/sellers within **120 days after initial hire date**.

NOTE! In the case of a sole proprietorship, Section 5/6-2 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act requires that the business owner reside within the jurisdiction that grants the local liquor license.

The questions below pertain to the applicant and any other person listed on the Contact Information Forms as owner /officer /partner /director /manager. **IF ANY QUESTIONS ARE ANSWERED WITH A "YES" ATTACH A FULL WRITTEN EXPLANATION.**

7. Yes No Have you ever been convicted of a gambling offense as defined under section 5/6-2 of the Act which includes offenses enumerated in 720 ILCS 5/28-1(a).11, "gambling;" 720 ILCS 5/28-1.1(a)-(d) "syndicated gambling;" and 720 ILCS 5/28-3 "keeping a gambling place"??
8. Yes No Have you ever been convicted of being the keeper of a house of ill fame; or of pandering or other crime or misdemeanor opposed to decency or morality?
