Job Description: A Public Works laborer is responsible for the operations of a variety of construction and maintenance equipment and for manual labor activities as needed and/or required for Public Works Dept. Although park grounds maintenance is, the most common type of worked performed, laborers in this position class also may work in road maintenance, assisting sign crews, and in other related areas in public works.

The position requires operation of the Village of Monee owned vehicles, such as pick-up trucks, backhoe, street sweeper, dump trucks, snow spreaders, snowplows, etc. as required.

The applicant will mow grass, prune trees and hedges, and plant trees as required. There is requirement to clean up litter and empty trash cans. Sweeping and clean up debris and materials from the roads will be required as well as snow and ice removal, including manual shoveling snow, conducting other job related duties such as maintenance of sanitary and storm sewers and making repairs and /or conducting routine maintenance procedures.

Requirements: A valid Illinois State driver license is required as well as knowledge and ability to operate Village of Monee owned vehicles and equipment. The candidate will be required to perform heavy manual labor, including lifting heavy objects up to 90 lbs. and working in all type of weather conditions. Safety procedures and practices are required, as well as wearing safety equipment. A good working relationship with coworkers and the public is a necessity. The candidate must be available for after hour call out emergencies such as snowfall, floods, downed trees, etc.
