

VILLAGE OF MONEE  
RE-OPENING BARS & RESTARAUNTS UNDER  
PHASE 3 RESTORE ILLINOIS

If your Bar and/or Restaurant were authorized to operate an outdoor serving area pre-COVID19, this section does not apply to you. FOLLOW THE APPLICABLE STATE GUIDELINES

If you operate a Bar and/or Restaurant and wish to add a temporary outdoor serving area, the following applies to you:

- Contact Building Services at 708-534-8303 to schedule an on-site meeting to discuss your plan
- Considerations taken into account for outdoor serving areas are safety, size of are requested, impact on neighbors (businesses or residents), etc.
- Once the area for outdoor service has been discussed with Building Services and given a preliminary “go ahead” a hand drawn sketch and application should be submitted to Building Services
- All temporary outdoor serving areas must be designated by temporary fencing, horses caution tape, other means of delineation
- Contact your insurance to get additional coverage on the temporary serving area (proof of insurance required)
- Once approved, Building Services will provide a NO CHARGE Building Permit good for operations for a 30 day period. This permit can be renewed.
- It will be the responsibility of the business to maintain adherence to state and local policies for all operations included under Phase 3 of the Restore Illinois plan. Please refer to the link below for Guidelines from Illinois DCEO
