OF ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Officers Electoral Board of the Village of Monee will hold a meeting of the Municipal Officers Electoral Board for the hearing and consideration of objections to nomination papers for candidates for Municipal offices to be voted upon by electors of said Municipal at the Consolidated Election to be held on April 6, 2021.

The Municipal Officers Electoral Board shall meet on Wednesday, January 6, 2021 at 2:00 p.m.at the Village of Monee Village Hall, 5130 Court Street, Monee IL 60449 for the purpose of hearing said objections to nomination papers. This meeting will be conducted by audio or video conference without a physically present quorum of the Municipal Officers Electoral Board because the Chairman has determined, pursuant to Section 7(e)(2) of the Open Meetings Act, that an in-person meeting at the Village Hall with all participants is not practical or prudent because of the disaster. Village officials, electoral board members, legal counsel, and the Village Administrator will not be physically present at the Village Hall if that is unfeasible due to the disaster. Physical public attendance at the Village Hall may be limited or not feasible, so alternative arrangements for public access to hear the meeting are available by contacting Village Clerk Doneshia Codjoe at 708-534-8301 or DCodjoe@villageofmonee.org at least an hour before the meeting. In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, the meeting will also be audio or video recorded and made available to the public, as provided by law.
