Representatives from Will County, the Village of Monee, and the project consultant will be present to discuss the project and answer any questions on an individual basis.

Due to the current restrictions in place for the Restore Illinois plan, attendance will be limited to 50 people at one time, including Village and WCDOT staff and consultant representatives, and a line may form. The meeting will be held indoors. All attendees must wear a mask and practice social distancing. No one will be allowed into the meeting without a mask. Anyone not comfortable with attending in
