Please have your branches at the curbside ready for pick up prior to the dates posted below. All dates are weather permitted. Please note: **We do not chip root balls or dirt.** Please have these items disposed of properly. We also will not chip trees that have been contracted for removal.

The Public Works Department understands severe weather events can take place that warrant clean-ups.

Branch Pick Up Dates: April 7th-8th; May 5th-6th; June 9th-10th; July 7th-8th; August 11th- 12th; Sept. 15th-16th; & Oct. 13th-14th
Nov. 17th-18th last branch pick up (weather permitted)

Republic Yard Waste Service is on your garbage day starting on April 1st.
Yard waste can be placed in either brown kraft paper bags or in your own containers marked with yard waste stickers which can be obtained at no charge by calling customer service at 708-385-8252 or at Village Hall. Containers cannot exceed 35 gallons in size or 40 pounds. Please Note: Tree branches in excess of 2 inches in diameter will not be removed. Tree branches must be bundled in a maximum 2 feet in diameter and 4 feet in length and weigh no more than 40 pounds. Yard waste in plastic bags is not acceptable.

Pet tags go on sale June 1st, \$10 / tag. Due by July 1st.


