



GOLF CART REGISTRATION

MONEE ORDINANCE 1878 PERMITS THE USE OF A GOLF CART/NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLE ON VILLAGE-OWNED STREETS WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS. ONLY THOSE VEHICLES WHICH HAVE BEEN REGISTERED AND INSPECTED BY THE MONEE POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE ALLOWED TO OPERATE WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS. APPROVED VEHICLES MUST DISPLAY THE CORRESPONDING REGISTRATION STICKER CONSPICUOUSLY ON THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE. UNIT MUST ABIDE BY ALL ORDINANCE 1878 REGULATIONS AS WELL AS ILLINOIS REVISED STATUTES.

Rules and Regulations
Ordinance #1878



Village Ordinance #1878 addresses the usage of Golf Carts/ Neighborhood Vehicles and Recreational Off Highway Vehicles (i.e.: Non- Highway Vehicles). This document is a summary of the rules for operation. It does not encompass the entire Ordinance or State Statutes. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to make themselves aware of all Village and State Statutes. ONLY Vehicles that have been inspected and approved by the Monee Police Department are allowed on Village streets per Ordinance. All approved vehicles must display the Village sticker conspicuously at the rear of the unit.

1. Non-Highway Vehicles are not allowed on any roadway in the Village with a posted speed limit of more than thirty (30) miles per hour. These vehicles may cross a roadway with a speed limit of thirty-five (35) miles per hour as long as they do so at an intersection.
2. Must have a valid Driver's License.
3. Must yield to motor vehicles.
4. Child car seat law APPLIES to Non-Highway Vehicles.
5. Cannot drive in a park, on a sidewalk or a trail that is controlled by the Village.
6. You cannot be on I-57. You cannot be on Rt. 50. When crossing a state-controlled highway (Rt. 50), you must use an intersection controlled by a traffic light or a 4-way stop. Court St. and Rt. 50 is your only option.
7. These rules pertain only to roads under the jurisdiction of the Village, Not Monee-Manhattan, Governors Highway, Will-Center south of Court St. They are either State or County jurisdiction. You cannot ride on these roads.
8. ATVs and off-road Motorcycles are prohibited. Illinois Status (1-101.8)
9. All required equipment must be operable.
10. Must have insurance.
11. Can only carry the number of people the unit was designed for.
12. A Village sticker/placard with a registration number must be displayed and visible.
